



Dear Swimming lesson customers,

We have really missed teaching your children to swim during these unprecedented times. We hope you're all safe and well.

As with the everchanging circumstances and guidance we have made the decision for lessons to be postponed until Saturday 5th September 2020. As we had started a new swimming block in March but Saturday lessons had missed 'week 1' due to the closure we will start with Saturday lessons on Saturday 5th September 2020. Week beginning Monday 7th September will then be 'week 2' of the scheme. Therefore, this block will run Saturday 5th September – Saturday 6th November 2020.

Following the guidance outlined by Swim England we currently only plan to reinstate lessons for Stage 4 Beginner – Stage 8 on a slightly adapted timetable to ensure safe distancing & changing room clean downs between each lesson. Please see attached timetable of classes below.

We hope to then bring Ducklings – Stage 3 groups and Rookie lifeguard back as soon as we can safely. We will continue to follow the guidance closely and any updates on these lessons starting will be sent out in a good time frame. We are following Swim England & government social distancing guidance strictly therefore this is how our decision has come about.

Your safety is our priority so please take a moment to read our changes:

- Class times revised this block to limit contact with others (Please see attached timetable)
- Swimmers to arrive at Leisure Centre reception holding area no more than 10 minutes before lesson start
- Swimmers to arrive beach ready
- Swimmers will be invited into 'Dry side' reception changing room to change into flip flops/sliders. All clothing items etc to go into bag for parent/guardian to keep hold of.
- Swimmers will then proceed down to poolside for their lesson. Swimmers can wear a towel or robe etc down to poolside.
- ONLY 1 PARENT/GUARDIAN TO ACCOMPANY SWIMMER & SPECTATE. We highly suggest where possible to not bring additional children as our spectator area can only hold so many spectators safely.
- ALL SPECTATORS NEED TO WEAR A FACE MASK ON SPECTATORS AREA
- Once lesson finishes swimmers will enter wet side changing rooms, parents/carers etc to bring clothing to swimmer. NO SHOWERS – just get dry asap and dressed.
- Swimmers will leave via the spectator door fire exit (one-way system sign posted)

We will have a walk-through tour video on our website and Facebook page soon, so you will have more of an idea of how it will look.
